

**All-Terrain Vehicle Route**  
**Village of Stetsonville, Taylor County**

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE ROUTES AND REGULATING THE  
OPERATION OF ALL- TERRAIN VEHICLES

**Section I – Intent**

The Village of Stetsonville, Taylor County adopts the following all-terrain vehicle route for the operation of all-terrain vehicles upon the roadways listed in Section III.

Following due consideration of the recreational value and weighted against possible dangers, public health, liability aspects, terrain involved, traffic density and history of automobile traffic, this route (s) has been created.

**Section II - Statutory Authority**

All terrain routes are adopted pursuant to Section 23.33 (8) (b), Wis. Stats.

The applicable provisions of 23.33 specifically regulating ATV operation within a village and the penalties for violations are hereby adopted by reference.

**Section III – Routes**

The following roads are designated as routes;

- A. All village streets except for State Highway 13 and Count Road A.
- B. The route to cross State Highway 13 is from Mink Ave to S. Cedar Street only. No other route shall be used within the village.
- C. All applicable routes are designated on a map available at the Village of Stetsonville Clerk's office.

**Section IV – Severability**

If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other person's circumstances shall not be deemed affected.

**Section V – Effective Date**

This ordinance becomes effective upon passage and publication.
