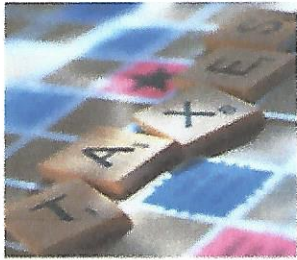


RESIDENTS OF THE VILLAGE OF STETSONVILLE



Your taxes can be mailed or placed in the drop off box located in the back hallway of the Jean M. Thomsen Memorial Library M-F from 10am-6pm

You may pay your taxes at the Village Office, located in the J.M.T.M. Library from 9am-2:30pm Monday-Friday. The office will be closed on December 24th, 25th, 28th and January 1st. The village office will have extended hours from 4pm-6pm on December 29th and December 30th. The office will be open from 9am to noon on December 31st. Starting January 4th the village office will be open Monday-Friday from 9am-2:30pm. You may also call 678-2191 to schedule an appointment.



DOG LICENSES may be paid with your taxes but please make out a separate check for the dog license. Proof of rabies vaccination must be provided in order to obtain a license. Any dog license not paid by April 1, 2016 will be turned over to the Taylor County District Attorney for collection and fines. If you have rental properties in the Village, remind your renters they need to license their dog(s).



Garbage/Recycling is open every Wednesday 5-7pm & Saturday 9am-1pm. \$3.00/bag or \$5.00/barrel & recyclables are free. Not all plastics are recyclable, check for the recycling emblem encircling the #1 thru #7 of all colors. Check the Taylor County website: www.co.taylor.wi.us for more information regarding recycling.



In order to receive a ballot for all future elections, voters will be required to show a valid photo ID. A current WI driver's license is acceptable but there are other forms of photo ID's that can be used--check out www.bringit.wi.gov for the specifics. The first election is February 16, with the next election on April 5, which includes the U.S. Presidential primary. We encourage everyone to make sure they have a valid photo ID.



Don't Flush Trouble - If it's not human waste or toilet paper, IT'S TROUBLE! Use a trash can to dispose of grease, used wipes, hygiene products and hair. The product label might say "flushable" but disposable wipes can damage pumps and clog sewer lines.



Remember to mow your lawn. According to State Statutes, grass and weeds are not to exceed 6" in height.



Remember to keep your past due water/sewer bill below \$300 to avoid receiving a disconnection notice. Landlords, please inform your tenants of this policy.



Please obey the **composting** signs and only dispose of brush and leaves. Leaf piles should not be raked into the street.

From November 1st thru April 1st there will be no overnight street parking from midnight until 7am so streets can be plowed. Do not plow snow into village streets and remember to keep your sidewalk clean.
